### 100. HOFFMAN INTERNATIONAL & QUILT SHOPS TOUR \$80

The first stop today will be at **Hoffman California-International Fabrics** ([www.hoffmanfabrics.com](http://www.hoffmanfabrics.com)). In 1924, Rube Hoffman founded Hoffman California Fabrics, selling wool flannels to California department stores and clothing manufacturers. Rube played an important role in the growth of California's textile industry. His sons, Philip and Walter, both championship surfers, joined the company in the 1950s and combined their passion for traveling to their favorite surfing spots with discovering unusual printing processes and different types of fabrics. Soon, Hoffman Fabrics abounded with their original designs of surfing scenes, beach life, and underwater settings.

Today, Hoffman creates more than 800 designs of colorful screen prints and luscious Bali batiks each year. Learn more about designing and printing this beautiful fabric while touring the facility.

Next you're off to **Quilter's Paradise** ([www.quiltersparadiseesc.com](http://www.quiltersparadiseesc.com)), located in Escondido. With over 9,000 square feet of only the best, high-quality fabrics from all major vendors, they are known for having one of the largest selections of Batik fabrics around. They offer professional quilting services with a Gammill longarm with computer-aided Statler Stitcher™ and a number of other unique services not found in many shops. They are also licensed by McKenna Ryan to provide laser cut kits for her intricate appliqué designs. Enjoy a delicious box lunch while visiting the shop.

The next stop is **Fat Quarters Quilt Shop** ([www.fatquartersquiltshop.com](http://www.fatquartersquiltshop.com)), located in Vista in an adorable grey farmhouse. There are lots of nooks and crannies with approx 4,000 bolts of assorted fabrics including flannels, reproductions, wools, 30s' fabrics, and more. There is also a huge variety of fabric, notions, patterns, and books, plus a great selection of gift items!

The last fabric shop today is **Sacred Moondance** (<http://sacredmoondance.com>)—formerly Material Possessions—in Lake Forest. Stroll through the wide variety of fabrics, books, and patterns that are available. They have a large selection of batiks, novelty prints, fabrics for children, and a wide variety of patterns for redwork and embroidery of all kinds.
