Description:	Work without a pattern. Work without a scant ¼" seam allowance. Work without straight lines. Create and cut as you go. In the class you will learn to piece curves without pins and create blocks like no one else has ever made before – these will be all your artwork.

	FABRICS:	
	Fabrics in a color pallet you would like to work in – no rules, just choose a color range and bring what you want. This is a great quilt for Fat Quarters and Fat Eights. Bring approximately 2 total yards, don't bring too much so that you are not held back from sewing taking too much time to choose fabrics. There is no right or wrong choice, just fun.	
BASIC SUPPLIES:		
	Rotary cutter, 45mm or 28mm size –I prefer the Olfa Ergonomic style and brand	
	Rotary mat: Mat 18" x 24" recommended	
	Ruler – a square that is at least $9\frac{1}{2}$ " – if you have one larger that is fine.	
	Ruler – 6"x24", or 6½" or 8½" wide	
	Sewing machine in good working order	
	100% Cotton 50 Weight piecing thread – neutral color	
	New Sewing machine needle – Size 70 Microtex for piecing	
	Spray Sizing – Mary Ellen's Best Press	
	Good quality seam ripper
