DIMENSIONAL APPLIQUÉ

In this class Philippa shows you how to create a three dimensional flower basket using various techniques to create a range of flowers and leaves.

Make rose and carnation like flowers, rouched flowers, flowers with individual petals, Maltese cross flowers, Suffolk puffs and tiny flower buds.

Philippa demonstrates how to make a 'bagged out' basket, and how to embellish this basket to give a beautiful textured result.



For this class you will need the following materials and equipment:

Fabrics:

1. Fabrics for the appliqué motifs. A small range of fine, high quality plain and print fabrics in fat quarter and smaller sized pieces. Philippa used Liberty lawn fabrics
2. You will be making samples and might like to bring a fat quarter piece of background fabric to sew these on to.
3. Scraps of soft batting/wadding for stuffing

Threads:

6. Strong general purpose polyester thread such as Gutterman's 'Sew All'
7. Shiny 40 weight polyester thread for satin stitch
8. Superior Threads 'Bottomline' or similar bobbin thread for satin stitch
9. Fine thread for discreet hand sewing (such as Superior Threads Kimono silk)

Other:

10. Steam-A-Seam or similar adhesive product
11. Karen Kay Buckley's Perfect Circles and Bigger Perfect Circles or other round templates
12. Hand needles to include embroidery needles in size 9 or 10 and long milliners/straw needles in size 9. Fine machine sewing needles in size 70.
13. Rotary cutting equipment to include mat, rotary cutter and medium length ruler
14. Scissors. Pinking shears are optional
15. Optional: single-sided fusible interfacing
