

Starting with Silk - A workshop with Julia McLeod

Supply List

- This class can be completed using about 8 neckties. Other silks from scarves, furnishings and clothing are also suitable. Avoid super sheer silk chiffon.
- For the background of the Flying Geese; about 1/4 yd of plain or contrasting fabric.
- Scraps or yardage of lightweight iron-on fusible interfacing. Good lightweight choices are Pellon's P44F, 906F and SF101 or Quilters Select Fabric Prep
- At least 1/4 yd plain lightweight cotton muslin, pre-washed if possible.
- Thread in a neutral color
- Scissors, thread snips, seam ripper, pins
- Rotary cutter with a good blade
- Cutting mat and ruler
- Notebook/Sketchbook, pen and pencil

I will have packs of silk fabrics, 1/2 yard cuts of dupioni silk and fusible interfacing available for purchase in class.
