

## **FREEZING YOUR BACKSIDES – Advanced Snow & Ice Fabric Dyeing With Cindy Lohbeck**

### Student Supply List

Art clothes or apron and comfortable shoes

30 large binder clips

1 plastic tote bin and lid – Approximately **24” x 18” x 6”**

\*\*You will have the option to do second 110” x 110” pattern for an additional \$80.

If you opt to do this, please bring a second bin.

Craft scissors

Permanent marker

18” to 24” acrylic ruler

Water soluble fabric marker or fabric marking pencil – medium color

1 or 2 large plastic bag (lawn & garden size)

Roll of paper towels



We will complete 90% of this project in class, but there will be rinsing and washing assigned as “Homework.” We are, after all, holding a dye class in a rather unusual location. Don’t fret - this is actually the fun part where you get to see your results!

Each facility is different, and some are more prepared than others. I have learned the quilters who take my classes are adaptable and resourceful and find the experience and resulting fabric stash well worth it!

We will wrap your project up in the bin, placed inside the plastic bag for safe transportation. There will be a few flat bed carts available, but many students choose to bring their own.

This is a fairly easy rinse that can easily be accomplished in half an hour to 45 minutes, depending on your pace and color choice. Detergent is provided. It can be completed in as soon as 3 or 4 hours, but can also be done the next day.
