Sample Blocks (for reference only)

Calypso is a great project for an intermediate scrap quilter! There are sections that are strip pieced and sub cut; and 3 pattern pieces! The sample quilt uses 4 different colorways with a light and dark color value which provides an interesting secondary pattern. This quilt would look great using 2 shades of one color plus 1 light fabric; 2 shades of one color with an accent color plus a light fabric; OR just make it totally scrappy using lights, mediums and darks!

Finished block size: 12" square

The quilt pattern includes directions for 4 sizes: Crib, Twin, Full and Queen.

For The Class:

This is a technique class so I will be teaching you my measuring, cutting, piecing and pressing techniques!

The goal is for you to complete one 12 ½" square block in class.

Please bring these fabrics to class for the sample block. This is a super way to use up your scraps either in one specific colorway or "everything but the kitchen sink". You can bring more fabric for more than one block if desired!

*** You will receive the pattern to make just 1 block; and the complete quilt pattern in class.**

Materials List to make 1 Block

Note: The color of the fabric refers to the pink and yellow block in the bottom right corner of the quilt in the quilt photo above. Please use whatever fabric colors you desire.

- > **Fabric C** (light pink) - One 1 7/8" x 36" strip
- > **Fabric E** (pink) - One 1 7/8" x 6" strip; two 1 7/8" x 4" strips; two 1 7/8" x 25" strips
- > **Fabric H** (yellow) - One 7 1/2" square
- > **Fabric J** (white) - Two 1 7/8" x 6" strips; one 1 7/8" x 4" strip; and four 3" squares

Sewing thread to match fabric

6" x 9" clear template plastic; permanent black #5 Pigman pen; and scissors to cut plastic (if desired)

Scissors to cut paper

Rotary cutter, ruler and cutting mat

Basic sewing supplies

We will discuss how to complete the quilt in class.

*IF you would like to bring your fabric for one of the quilt sizes below, please do so if you'd like to!
The fabric colors noted below are for reference only for the entire quilt above as shown. Again, please choose your own colors if desired.*

Crib Size – 12 blocks – 49 1/2" x 61 1/2"

Twin – 24 blocks – 70 1/2" x 94 1/2"

Full – 30 blocks – 82 1/2" x 94 1/2"

Queen – 42 blocks – 96 1/2" x 108 1/2"

Fabric A (light blue)

Crib – 1/8 yard

Twin – 1/3 yard

Full – 3/8 yard

Queen – 1/2 yard

Fabric B (light green)

Crib – 1/8 yard

Twin – 1/3 yard

Full – 1/2 yard

Queen – 5/8 yard

Fabric C (light pink)

Crib – 1/8 yard

Twin – 1/3 yard

Full – 1/2 yard

Queen – 5/8 yard

Fabric D (light purple)

Crib – 1/8 yard

Twin – 1/3 yard

Full – 3/8 yard

Queen – 1/2 yard

Fabric E (pink) - *used in blocks, and second border*

Crib – 2/3 yard

Twin – 1 1/8 yards

Full – 1 1/6 yards

Queen – 1 5/8 yards

Fabric F (purple)

Crib – 1/3 yard

Twin – 5/8 yard

Full – 5/8 yard

Queen – 3/4 yard

Fabric G (green)

Crib – 1/3 yard

Twin – 1 1/3 yards

Full – 1 1/2 yards

Queen – 2 yards

Fabric H (yellow)

Crib – 7/8 yard

Twin – 1 1/3 yards

Full – 1 1/2 yards

Queen – 2 yards

Fabric I (blue) – *used in blocks, outer border, and binding*

Crib – 1 3/8 yards

Twin – 2 3/8 yards

Full – 2 2/3 yards

Queen – 3 yards

Fabric I (white)

Crib – 1 yard

Twin – 1 5/8 yards

Full – 1 3/4 yards

Queen – 2 1/4 yards
