Piping and Binding

Half Day - All Levels.

Add a final stylish flourish to your quilts. A practical class where you learn to finish the edges of your quilts using the techniques employed in award winning quilts. Contrasting fabric covered piping and double folded binding are attached by machine to give beautiful straight edges, perfect corners and invisible joins.

What you need to bring with you:

1. Three different fat quarters.
2. Two quilt sandwiches with low loft wadding/batting. Min size 16" x 10".
Please do not use high loft wadding as it is too puffy for these samples.
You can sew a few lines of stitching across these sandwiches if you wish.
3. Needles for hand and machine sewing.
4. Rotary cutter and mat.
5. Ruler minimum 18" long
6. Quilters square minimum 6" (or triangular 'ruler' 6" min)
7. A 1" x 6" Or 1" x 12" quilters ruler Omnigrid is the best make. Please note this ruler is essential for the piping technique and is not an ordinary small ruler (alternative is Susan Cleveland's 'Piping Hot Binding Tool).
8. Pins
9. Scissors for fabric and thread cutting
10. Thread
11. Notebook and pen/pencil
