

GEESE OVER MANHATTAN SUPPLY LIST

BRING:

Fabric

- Center fabric: $\frac{1}{2}$ yard. More for fussy cutting images.
- Fabric(s) for the centers of flying geese: You will need a total of $\frac{7}{8}$ yards. This can be one fabric, several fabrics or scraps of many fabrics.
- Fabric(s) for sides of flying geese fabric: $1\frac{1}{8}$ yards
- Narrow border fabric: Regular $\frac{1}{4}$ yard
- Sashing: 1 yard
- Border fabric: $1\frac{1}{2}$ yards to avoid seaming the borders. Using $1\frac{1}{8}$ yards, you'll need to seam the borders.
- Binding: $\frac{5}{8}$ yards
- Backing: $3\frac{5}{8}$ yards

Supplies

- Neutral thread for piecing
- New sewing-machine needle, Microtex recommended
- Straight pins
- Add-a-Quarter ruler if you have one
- Rotary cutter with new blade
- Square ruler 8" x 8" or larger or any ruler that is 8" wide or wider (for example 8" x 12" or 8" x 24" will be fine)
- Kit from teacher includes the pattern and foundations.
