Design Details: Winter Deer Art Quilt

Finished Size: 16.5" x 11.5"

Bring the beauty of Mosaics to your Quilt making. Learn about Proffetty's mosaic quilt making techniques while you peacefully puzzle together a winter deer mosaic design. She'll discuss and demonstrate the steps to create a mosaic quilt from a photograph, such as drawing the mosaic shapes, recognizing values in photos and how to translate them to colors and choose fabrics. She offers traditional and digital design and cutting techniques along with her recipes for success in finishing the quilt.

Kit Includes: Color Placement Guide, Cotton Foundation, Pre-Fused and Pre-cut Applique Batik Fabric Pieces, Thread, Batting, Backing and Binding fabric pieces.

Teacher Supplies: Press cloths, Carrier Sheet, Water bottles, Samples and any Additional Handouts

Facility Provides: Irons & Iron boards

Required Supplies: *Please bring the following items to class.*

- Notebook, pen/pencil for notetaking
- Small sharp fine-tip scissors or snips
- Precision Tip Tweezers (I sell these in my shop at www.HeidiProffetty.com/shop)
- Elmer's washable glue stick
- 1 Large gallon freezer baggie for project
- Small paper trash bag

Note: We will be picking up and precisely placing lots of very small pre-fused adhesive fabric pieces to build this design, almost like building a puzzle. It's a MUST to have a pair of good precision, pointy tipped tweezers and your glasses, if needed.
