

## **Maltese Cross - Turned-Edge Machine Appliqué taught by Karen K. Stone**

**15-20 neckties** or fat quarters. Try to include lights, darks, and brights. If some are especially busy, also include some that are calmer and read more solid. (Don't be afraid - the weirder, the better :)

(If neckties, no preparation is needed.)

**Pinnable personal ironing board** (pins will stand straight up firmly). This can be a lightweight board with a layer of foam and batting covered with muslin, or a few layers of foam core glued together, or a piece of insulation covered with muslin, or a purchased board e.g. June Taylor's Cut and Press board. It should be about 12" x 18".

Monofilament thread (clear or smoke polyester)

Rotary cutting supplies, medium.

Basic supplies: Fabric scissors, straight pins
