## **Supply List**

**Skill Level: Beginner/Intermediate** Sewing Machine Needed for Class

**Design Details:** 3 Original Stitch Art Designs

Learn a fabulous new technique, Decorative Stitch Art with Sewing Machine Stitches. Many sewing machines come with hundreds of stitches. How fun would it be to create some stitch art designs using these wonderful stitches? You can make custom stitch art designs to embellish quilts, clothing, home décor items or server as stand-alone pieces of art. There will be plenty of oohh's and aahh's in this class and you'll leave excited to go home and create your own stitch art designs.

**Kit Includes:** Design templates, instructional stitch charts, black and white precut cotton fabric squares, stabilizer, transfer paper, 6" metric ruler, and PVC card.

Teacher Supplies: Pressing cloths, Water bottles, Practice pieces, Tape, Samples and any additional Handouts

Facility Provides: Irons & Iron boards

**Required Supplies:** *Please bring the following items to class.* 

- Notebook, pen/pencil for notetaking
- Glasses/Reading glasses if needed
- Small sharp fine-tip scissors or embroidery snips
- Precision Tip Tweezers (I sell these in my shop at <a href="www.HeidiProffetty.com/shop">www.HeidiProffetty.com/shop</a>)
- 1 Large gallon freezer baggie for project
- Fine tip blue water-soluble fabric marker (Mark B Gone Fine Tip)
- Fine tip white mechanical chalk pencil/pen (Fons & Porter or Sewline)
- 7 standard size spools of (your preferred brand) 40 weight embroidery thread (rayon or polyester). Colors: light blue, royal or electric blue (NOT NAVY), gold, bright yellow, bright green, kelly or grass green, medium brown.

**Note:** If students prefer to have the teacher supply the threads, there will be an Bundled Thread Kit available for pre-purchase on my website specifically for this class at International Quilt Festival. It includes: (7) standard sized spools of 40 weight embroidery thread in the colors necessary for these designs.
