Class name:	English Paper Piecing by Machine
Description:	<p>This method of EPP can be done by machine with no need to remove any paper. Students will be working with larger sized hexagon quilt but the technique can be used when making smaller traditional projects also. This project quilt is approximately 65" square design.</p> <p>In this class you will create 2-3 "flowers", learn how to incorporate this technique into other designs and finishing techniques.</p>

<input type="checkbox"/>	5-7 Fat Quarters of coordinating fabrics for your flowers – One for the flower centers and one fat quarter for each flower and one for the edges. The borders can be selected at a later time.
SUPPLIES:	
<input type="checkbox"/>	"My Mother's Flower Garden" by Nancy Roelfsema – part of the kit price
<input type="checkbox"/>	One pack of Ricky Tims "Stable Stuff" stabilizer – Part of the kit price
<input type="checkbox"/>	Rotary cutter, 45mm size new blade
<input type="checkbox"/>	Rotary mat any size
<input type="checkbox"/>	Ruler – 6"x12" or larger
<input type="checkbox"/>	Sharp pair of scissors
<input type="checkbox"/>	Invisible thread and a fine weight polyester thread for the bobbin.
<input type="checkbox"/>	Water soluble, acid free glue stick – the UHU brand is very nice. You will need at least 2 smaller sticks or one large stick.
