<b>Class name:</b>	<b>Improvitational Piecing</b>
<b>Description:</b>	<b>Work without a pattern. Work without a scant 1/4" seam allowance. Work without straight lines. Create and cut as you go. In the class you will learn to piece curves without pins and create blocks like no one else has ever made before – these will be all your artwork.</b>

**SUPPLY LIST**

<input type="checkbox"/>	<b>FABRICS:</b>	
	Fabrics in a color pallet you would like to work in – no rules, just choose a color range and bring what you want. This is a great quilt for Fat Quarters and Fat Eights. Bring approximately 2 total yards, don't bring too much so that you are not held back from sewing taking too much time to choose fabrics. There is no right or wrong choice, just fun.	

**BASIC SUPPLIES:**

<input type="checkbox"/>	Rotary cutter, 45mm or 28mm size –	
<input type="checkbox"/>	Rotary mat: Mat 18" x 24" recommended	
<input type="checkbox"/>	Ruler – smaller in size – approximately 4"x12"	
<input type="checkbox"/>	100% Cotton 50 Weight piecing thread – neutral color –	
<input type="checkbox"/>	New Sewing machine needle – Size 70 Microtex for piecing	
<input type="checkbox"/>	Spray Sizing –	
	Pins
