CLASS INFORMATION	
Class name:	Fractured Glass – Foundation Paper Pieced
Description:	Every quilter wants to make eye-catching quilts and this quilt is just that. Follow along as Nancy shows you all how to create quilt blocks that look like stained glass. You'll be amazed how quickly it comes together! These block designs are foundation paper pieced using a special technique.

SUPPLY LIST	
<input type="checkbox"/>	FABRICS:
	During class you will start 5 blocks. Each block measures approximately 7 inches. If you choose to make the quilt larger you will need more fabrics but we will concentrate on technique so you will not need to bring tons of fabric to class – try to control yourself so you don't get too distracting playing with fabrics during class.
<input type="checkbox"/>	Precut before class - Five fabrics cut 10" square for the "glass" in the blocks
<input type="checkbox"/>	Grout – solid black – ½ yard precut into 1" strips
	BASIC SUPPLIES:
<input type="checkbox"/>	“ADD-AN-EIGHTH” RULER BY CM DESIGN – THE TEACHER WILL BRING THESE FOR PURCHASE JUST IN CASE YOU ARE HAVING TROUBLE FINDING THIS SPACIFIC RULER – IT IS NECCISARY 😊
<input type="checkbox"/>	Rotary cutter- 28mm size
<input type="checkbox"/>	Rotary mat: Mat no bigger than 18" x 24" recommended, a smaller mat will work, no smaller than 6x6
<input type="checkbox"/>	100% Cotton 50 Weight piecing thread – neutral color that would coordinate with your chosen fabrics.
<input type="checkbox"/>	Straight pins
<input type="checkbox"/>	Spray Sizing
