Learn to Deconstruct Old Jeans into a New Quilt

Many years ago, I was sitting with three plastic binds of old jeans from my family member. At the time I wanted to produce quilts made from old denim. I had to first learn how to deconstruct the denim and then how to cut and resew the denim using the conventional sewing methods. The learning curve was big with a great deal of ups and down. I have so much to teach you and now is the time to get started.

I am absolutely thrilled to now pass all the information I learned about deconstruction of old jeans. It's time for me to walk you through the steps of the process of sewing a quilt using deconstructed denim.

MATERIALS

- Maggie's Square pattern (
- Old jeans larger sized are best (no stretch) you will need the following colors: (you will get several colors from one pair of pants)
 - Very light color
 - Light color
 - Medium Light
 - Medium
 - Dark
- Backing fabric*
- Hand sewing needle
- Straight pins
- Rotary cutters, cutting mat, and ruler
- Scissors
- Thread for sewing
- Batting (thin) *
- You will not need these items for the workshop but to complete the guilt.
