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## FABRIC REQUIREMENTS:

Quilt size: Crib Size 45.25 " x 45.25 " You can always enlarge by making more blocks This project is great for using scraps/fat quarters

Background Fabrics--1.5 yards of various light fabrics
Dark Fabrics--1 yard of various prints
Medium Fabrics-- 2.25 yards of various prints
If you want all the geese in the sashing to be the same: 1 yard of EACH fabric is needed, "geese" and "sky"

## SUPPLIES:

Sewing Thread, $100 \%$ cotton thread or Cotton/Poly like Quilters Select 60 wt. neutral gray or beige Scissors for cutting plastic
Scissors for fabric and thread
Paper and Mechanical Pencil-for notes and marking the back of fabrics
Basic sewing supplies: Stitch Ripper, pins, fabric markers
Rotary cutter with sharp blade
Rotary Cutting mat: Size to cut strips, either $12^{\prime \prime} \times 18^{\prime \prime}$ or $18^{\prime \prime} \times 24^{\prime \prime}$
Rotary Cutting rulers: $6^{\prime \prime} \times 12^{\prime \prime}$ or larger AND $6.5^{\prime \prime}$ square ruler, or similar
Add-A-Quarter Ruler, 6 " size is sufficient
