

Class Title: Quilt Studio Planning and Design Intensive Taught by Lois Hallock

Duration: 6 hours

Format: Instruction mixed with hands on studio planning using scale furniture models and graph paper

Learn the basics of creative studio space design along with conquering organizing and ergonomic challenges. Artists bring their room dimensions and photographs of their current studio workspace. Class is guided through instruction alternating with in classroom work to design the most optimal space for their needs with the best storage solutions. Goal is for students to walk away with their ideal studio layout along with recommendations for furniture and storage solutions.

Pre-work by Quilters:

- Rough Sketch of room layout with furniture (note we will be working at $\frac{1}{2}'' = 1$ foot scale in class if you want to work ahead).
- Measure room dimensions and write on those dimensions on the sketch (include windows and doors).
- Mark electrical outlets, switches, and heating vent locations on sketch. Mark any permanent room elements like fireplaces, etc.
- Measure furniture dimensions in inches (Height, width, and depth)
- Measure Fabric Stash volume (use worksheet below)
- Take photos of your room and bring printed pictures or memory stick for sharing on the big screen (optional)
