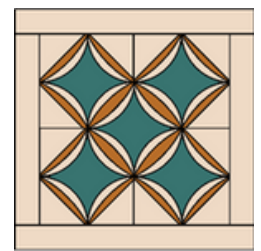
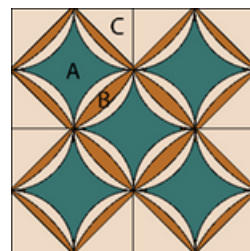

# SUPPLIES

<b>Color A</b> *non directional	(5) 4½" squares
<b>Color B</b> *non directional	(16) 4" squares
<b>Color C (frames)</b> low volume *non directional	(32) 4" squares
<b>Color C</b> for borders *non directional	(2) 3½" x 14½" strips
<b>Color C</b> for borders *non directional	(2) 3½" x 20½" strips

- Glue Baste (Roxanne Glue-Baste It )
- Thread
- Snips
- Clover mini clips and pins
- Stiletto
- Alphabet labels A, B and C
- **Bring your pre-cut fabrics (see above)**
- **Press all 4" C squares in half on the diagonal (they will be the shape of a triangle after pressing) prior to class since the classroom only has limited irons.**
