

Improvisational English Paper Piecing with Tina Craig

Improv isn't just for machine stitching! Learn the basics of English Paper Piecing, and create a project that is uniquely yours. Instruction will include designing, basting, hand stitching, and finishing. You'll have the option to make your mug mat either a rectangle or a hexagon. Class handout will include instructions for finishing your mug mat after class.

Supply List

Fabric: assorted scraps, fat eighths or fat quarters.
Gather at least 4 coordinating fabrics. I like the look of solids for improv, but prints work well, too.

Fabric glue pen and refills, any brand

Hand stitching needles- Straw or Milliner size 9-11

Thin thread such as Superior Bottom Line
(60 wt 2-ply polyester)

Thimble that works for you

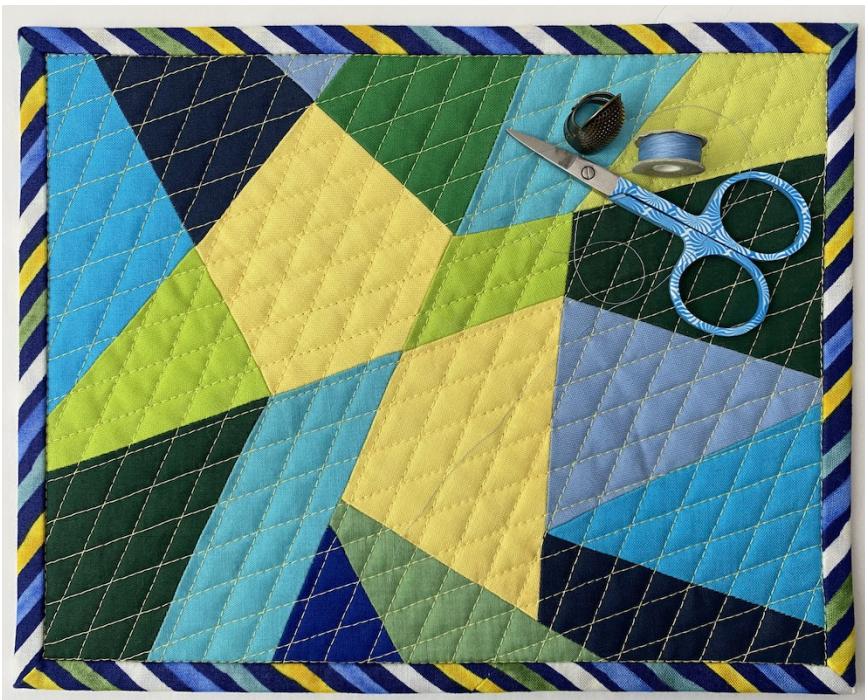
Separate scissors for paper and fabric

Pencil with eraser

12" Ruler, any width (a school ruler will do)

Colored pencils or crayons, optional

Paper tape or masking tape, optional
