Drawing classes

- Allow me to teach many more designs than I would be able to with machines in the room. Expect
 to be blown-away by the number of designs you will learn!
- They allow everyone to join us, no matter what type of machine you sew on (longarm to domestic) everyone's welcome.
- There's no need to haul lots of supplies!
- Don't be swayed into thinking drawing classes are any less valuable than a classroom with machines. In fact, students are able to learn more quickly and confidently if they learn first to draw the designs before going to the machine.

Supply List

- A 0.7mm mechanical pencil (like the Bic® Brand found at Target or Walmart), and a ballpoint pen, each with a comfort grip.
- 2-4 sheets of unlined paper for notes and a few drawings (printer paper works well). Most of your designs will be drawn on handouts, which will be provided.
