Quilt-as-you-go

Materials

To ensure a seamless and creative experience, please assemble the following materials and tools for our class:

1. **Precut Batting Squares:** You'll need 12 precut batting squares, each measuring 15 inches by 15 inches.
2. **Cotton Thread Selection:** Bring along several colors of cotton thread. This allows you to experiment and decide on your accent color thread, or you can explore the use of variegated thread (*a student favorite*) for quilting details.
3. **Fabric Assortment:** Prepare a variety of fat quarters and fabric scraps in both light and dark shades. It's recommended to have at least 2 dozen or more pieces to ensure creative freedom.
4. **Square Ruler and Rotary Tools:** Don't forget to bring a large square ruler and a sharp rotary knife with a cutting mat. These tools are essential for squaring up your blocks to a precise 14 inches by 14 inches.
5. **Basic Sewing Supplies:** Ensure you have your favorite basic sewing supplies, including scissors and pins, ready for use.

With these materials and tools at your disposal, you'll be well-equipped to create your quilt blocks and make the most of our class.
