

Mad Modern Rulerwork for Beginners Supply List

Classroom Provided Supplies and Materials

(In a sponsored classroom where machines are provided, these should be provided, but are included here for your reference.)

- Machine in good order
- Rulerfoot to match your machine
- Machine Screwdriver if required
- Straight Stitch Throat Plate if it fits the machine rulerfoot setup
- Polyester 40wt
- Bobbins

- Appropriate Spool caps including the tiny, special purpose spool cap
- 90/14 Topstitch or Quilting needle
- Machine extension table such as a Sew Steady table (HIGHLY recommended)

Students must bring the following standard quilting supplies:

- Thread snips
- Quilt safe marking tools such as chalk pencils that will show up on your fabric. (Kit fabric will be dark solids for easy visuals.)
- Rotary rulers for marking such as a 3" x 18" and an 8" square or equivalent. These will just be used to mark reference lines, so no specific size is required.
- Seat Cushion: this is optional, though highly recommended to help you sit at the correct height. This makes the technique much easier.

Note: This is a full day class. As many designs as possible will be included in the time allowed. Please eat breakfast before class and have a good night's rest the day before. Students will have the opportunity to work at their own pace in the afternoon portion of the class.

Kit Items: (\$55):

- 20" Premarked quilt sandwich. (Similar to the sampler but slightly smaller for class.)
- 1 Spool of Magnifico Polyester Thread from Superior Threads and matching bobbin
- 1 10" quilt sandwich square for machine setup.
- Kit fee also covers the cost of loaner tools and templates including the Westalee spacing gauge, 12" arc and Sampler Set templates, Clover Chaco Liners with Pounce iron-off chalk, and the freemotion gliders which will be turned in after class.
