Class name: LeMoyne Star

Description:

The Lemoyne Star block is a timeless quilt design that has captivated crafters since the early 1900s. While there are several techniques to create this block, I strongly recommend the classic method featuring set-in seams. This approach not only enhances your skill set but also builds a foundation for countless future quilting projects. My easy-to-follow technique removes the intimidation often associated with set-in seams, empowering you to achieve beautiful results with confidence.

SUPPLY LIST

FABRICS:

In the class we will work on piecing two 8" LeMoyne star blocks.

For the class you can bring just a few fabrics.

Three fabrics is all you will need.

Three fat quarters or quarter yard sections. Two for the stars and one for the background.

BEFORE CLASS:

Before you cut the fabrics you will need to use Spray Sizing to stiffen the fabrics – two coats of sizing should make the fabrics approximately as stiff as a piece of copy paper.

BASIC SUPPLIES:

- ☐ Rotary cutter, 45mm
- ☐ Rotary mat: Mat 18" x 24"
- ☐ Ruler – a 4x14 ruler is the perfect size but any ruler will work
- ☐ Ruler – 9x9 or 12x12 square
- ☐ 100% Cotton 50 Weight piecing thread – neutral color –

- ☐ Straight pins

- ☐ Seam Guilds from Guildlines4Quilters.

- these are the perfect tool for making the perfect scant 1/4" seam allowance.



- ☐ Glow Tape for your ruler and be helpful
