

Collage Chic Jacket

Supply list

June Colburn

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Pattern:

Asian Quarters Jacket, sizes XS-XL (36"-53" + 11" ease), \$15.00 + \$2.00 postage

Please **order** at least 6 weeks prior to class, by e-mail to:

(Students may use another simple pattern instead.)

Fabric:

3 ½ yards of 42"-45" wide **cotton muslin**, for *foundation: pre-washed, pre-shrunk, cut to correct size and sewn together only at shoulder seams.

(NOTE: More yardage may be needed for longer jackets.)

4 yards total of **8-12 cotton** and/or **linen prints** and/or **batiks**. Fabrics should be about the same weight and a mix of bold, medium and small sized **dense prints** in a defined, color coordinated group. Solids should not be included, although self-prints may be used. **TIP:** Find many bold-scale prints in decorator-weight cottons. (**Additional information** about fabric selection will be sent with the pattern.)

3 ½ yards of cotton, linen, or silk for reversible/lining side—not needed in class!

1 yd. 22" -36" wide fusible tricot interfacing—not needed in class!

Notions: listed on pattern, not needed in class.

Supply list:

Small, sharp fabric scissors

Pins and fabric glue stick

Bag for scraps

Eyeglasses, as needed for close work

Optional supplies:

*Paper foundation instead of muslin

Heat 'n Bond Lite fusible web (optional)

Battery-operated Ott Light (optional)
