

Creative Crosshatching Rulerwork for Beginners Supply List

Classroom Provided Supplies and Materials

(In a sponsored classroom where machines are provided, these should be provided, but are included here for your reference.)

- Machine in good order
- Rulerfoot to match your machine
- Machine Screwdriver if required
- Straight Stitch Throat Plate if it fits the machine rulerfoot setup
- Polyester 40wt

- Bobbins
- Appropriate Spool caps including the tiny, special purpose spool cap
- 90/14 Topstitch or Quilting needle
- Machine extension table

Students must bring the following standard quilting supplies:

- Thread snips
- Quilt safe marking tools. Kit fabrics are dark fabrics, so chalk is useful.
- Rotary ruler for measuring and marking on the quilt sandwich (8"square or so)
- Seat Cushion is an optional but highly recommended item to sit at the proper height for this technique.
- 6" square ruler will be used to mark off the crosshatch spaces. Bring this size or a ruler that can be used to easily mark a box to this size.

<u>Kit Items: (\$35):</u>

- Westalee Wave Template (Low shank templates will be supplied unless a student makes a specific request. (Low shank style will work on both high and low shank machines but not on longarm style of machine. Please make your specific requests NLT 30 days before the event, Sep 9th, 2025.)
- 2 fat quarter quilt sandwiches
- 1 Spool of Magnifico Polyester Thread from Superior Threads and matching bobbin
- Kit fee also covers the cost of loaner tools and templates including the Westalee spacing gauge, 12" arc, Clover Chaco Liners with Pounce iron-off chalk, and the freemotion gliders which will be turned in after class.
