Supply List

The Following Items are REQUIRED for the Workshop. Please make sure to bring them with you.

Scrappy Applique Pattern

Digital patterns must be purchased before the workshop. To purchase individual patterns, go to tiny.cc/sbpatterns. To get access to ALL patterns, consider becoming a member of the Scrappy Applique School & Library, tiny.cc/allsapatterns. Please print and tape together your pattern before the workshop. If using small patterns, you may want to bring more than one.

Scrap Fabric for the Collaged Applique Piece

The equivalent of 8-12 fat eighths or sixteenths should be plenty. You can use scraps from your scrap bin. I recommend pieces at least 4" X 8" for your first project. Having at least 8-12 different fabrics works best. Feel free to bring more with you!

Background Fabric

See your pattern for yardage needed - basically, the size you want for your finished quilt or project.

Reynolds Parchment Paper (not generic) or 2 Applique Pressing Sheets

Marking Pen that WILL NOT be Removed by Heat

Micron pens (Size 08 or higher) or other pens that won't smear easily work great.

Basic Sewing Supplies

Cutting mat, rotary cutter and blades, fabric scissors (large and small).

Ziplock Bags

To use for storing leftover fused fabric. (1 for each piece or color of fabric)

The following items will be included in the class kit purchased when registering for the class.

- -Fusible Web (2 Yards of MistyFuse)
- -Fusible Interfacing (2 Yards of Pellon 906F)

Needed at Home When Finishing Your Project

I recommend Sulky's Totally Stable or Sticky+, both tear-away stabilizers. Needed only if you finish your applique with a satin stitch.

Clear Polyester Monofilament Thread

This will be used for topstitching. Alternatively, you can use a fine-weight (80-100wt) coordinating color of thread.

Dritz Fray Check

Optional, but helpful for securing your raw edges.

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
