Student Supply List

Art clothes or apron and comfortable shoes

1 plastic tote bin and lid – Approximately **24” x 18” x 6”**

Craft scissors

3 large plastic bag (lawn & garden size)

Roll of paper towels

Spring Clamps!!! – The more clamps you use per template, the better the resist!

To get the best stars, you will need a clamp on each point. I recommend at least 20 clamps ranging from 4” to 6”.



We will complete 90% of this project in class, but there will be rinsing and washing assigned as “Homework.” We are, after all, holding a dye class in a rather unusual location. Don’t fret - this is actually the fun part where you get to see your results!

This is a fairly easy rinse that can easily be accomplished in half an hour to 45 minutes, however, it is suggested you let this project “batch” for a minimum of 8 hours and up to 24 for the richest colors results.
