



4-Patch Wedding Ring Block Supply List



Students must bring the following tools to class:

- 45mm Rotary Cutter with a new blade
- Snips or Scissors to trim threads from chain piecing
- Pins, Pins, Pins (Short, strong pins are best. Long, thin ones are not as useful here)
- Fine Point Quilt Safe marker such a chalk pencil or air erase marker to mark seam intersections.
- Seam ripper
- 12" cutting mat. A rotating or spinnable mat is helpful to have but not required.

Important Technical Notes for this class:

Here are the skills required to achieve success in this class. All students are welcome but without these skills the class may be more difficult. These are the reasons that the class is not noted as a beginner class.

1. Cutting using a rotary cutter is an important aspect of this class. Students will use a plastic template shapes and a rotary cutter to cut out pieces for this block. Some familiarity with a rotary cutter is important for this class.
2. Students must have some understanding of a quarter inch seam for this class. Tools will be available in class to help you achieve a quarter inch seam, but you need to be aware that this quilt block requires some precision to be successful.
3. Students can expect to finish 2 of the 4-patch blocks (shown in the block image on the right) during class and may have to complete the rest at home depending on each individual's work pace.

Class kit contents (\$55)

This scrappy kit comes with some precut units and fabric to make a 4-patch 15.5" block.

- 1) Westalee Double Wedding Ring Cutting Template Set 1 (4 pieces)
- 2) 50 precut pieces to make the scrappy "rings"
- 3) 3 - 8" Black Square precut and folded for cutting
- 4) 2 - 8" White fabric squares precut and folded for cutting
- 5) 2 precut black and white graphic rings
- 6) 8 - 2.5" squares for the "ring" corner caps
- 7) Block Assembly and Pressing Guide Handout

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
