Consider using Jelly Rolls and Honey Buns precut fabric sets.

In this inspiring class, you'll explore playful design possibilities perfect for a 42" x 42" striking wall hanging—or let your creativity grow it into a full-size quilt. You'll be challenged and very intentional in use of colors using this technique -- ideal for beginners ready to try something new and for seasoned sewists seeking a fun challenge. Instructor invites you to create, learn and open the door to a beautifully curvy world of quilting innovation!



SUPPLY LIST

This instructional session is designed to make only four (4) blocks. @14 x 14" inch curved log cabin squares

Materials: Basic sewing tools

- – neutral thread to blend
- flat-head pins
- - rotary cutter
- - Seam ripper
- - Scissors for snipping threads - rotating mat is very useful
- - 6" x 24" or long ruler

Common Fabric Yardage (Example for a quilt)

$\frac{3}{4}$ yard each - cut 6-8 color/darker fabric

2 yard cut light a background fabric

OR / Alternative

- 2 Jelly Rolls (varied) 2.5 inch precut strips
- 2 Honey Bun Rolls (light) 1.5 inch precut strips
