Supply List:

Basic supplies, including piecing thread, and good scissors.

Sewing machines are provided for use in class. Sewing machine (to finish the project at home) in good working order, with quarter-inch foot or your favorite for piecing.

Rotary cutter and mat.

Personal iron and board are not allowed in class.

Spray sizing

Basting glue (Elmer's washable school).

Fabric: 15-20 Solids (fat quarters or half-yards are great) in a variety of colors and values so that you have options.
