Your Fabric Choices: Bring to Class

1/3 yard of three complimentary/contrasting colorful fabrics of your choice. This will form the three star points of the star unit.

1/3 yard of light/or dark fabric: the background of the star unit

Cutting Mat (medium size)	ruler 12” or larger
rotary cutter with a new blade	seam ripper
straight pins, pin cushion	Scissors to snip threads
gray or other neutral color thread
