Foundation paper piecing is a precision piecing method, which uses paper both as a pattern and a stabilizer, and this helps to produce perfect points and accurate blocks. It's a straightforward technique once mastered --- I allow myself to slow my pace and gather my thoughts as I let the fabric speak to me!

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SUPPLY LIST

• Kit – distributed in class / prepaid in your registration) contains 4 copies of FPP Templates to make one (1) 8" Twirling Starr

- Mat (medium size)
- 12" or 24" ruler
- rotary cutter with a new blade
- seam ripper
- gray or other neutral color thread
- Sharp Snippet scissors to cut thread
- Flat head pin or glue stick
- Add-a-quarter ruler (optional)
- Tailor's clappers (optional)
- Fabric for blocks as outlined on the pattern list on the next page
- In order to save time you may cut out the pieces as outlined on the pattern list. Labeling the pieces will help you save time!

This class uses an original pattern designed in the style taught by Carol Doak. Instructor tips, tricks, will provide clear guidance for breaking down each step of the FPP process.
