An introductory class in walking foot quilting. Learn how to finish your quilts on a domestic machine while enjoying all the control of your walking foot. We will begin with a brief discussion of preparing your tops for quilting, including pressing technique and basting. Then, we will make stitched samples of different styles including matchstick quilting, grids, combined stitches, and serpentes. Find out how Catherine adds hand stitching to her quilts. Be inspired to go home and turn your tops into quilts.
