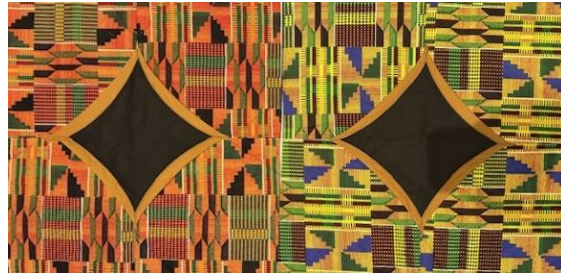


Windows of Wonderment



SUPPLY LIST

- Cutting Mat (medium size)
- ruler 12” or larger
- rotary cutter with a new blade
- straight pins, pin cushion, seam ripper, scissors to snip threads
- gray or neutral color thread
- 10” fabric squares for background – total - sixteen (16) needed
 - This background can be bold as illustrated, or any grouping of solid or blended fabric choices
- 14.5” square fabric to contrast that forms the WOW curve – total – four (4) needed
 - This creates a fun dramatic curved/folded edge as a border
- 12” square fabric to dazzle as the insert into your WOW – total – four (4) needed
 - This adds a big pop of any color/solid or even a fussy cut fabric for center

NOTE: *Sewing machine and Irons will be provided for use in class.*

Choose solid backgrounds or any combination of fabric colors- even fussy cuts or bold geometric designs. Beverly presents a new twist of layering within her pattern yet stitching **straight seams** and **curved line designs!**
